Procedure

Submitting the application

The application for requesting a licence (issue, exchange, replacement of licence) to possess category "A" ammunition and automatic firearms must be submitted to the relevant county police department of the place of activity (storage); in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters.

Costs and expenses of the procedure

The administrative service fee for a licence to possess automatic firearms shall be HUF 3,000 for each firearm. The fee for authorising an employee to handle and be held liable for firearms and ammunition as well as authorising a trade representative to act as an employee shall be HUF 2,000 per person. Permits for storage of firearms and/or, ammunition shall be as follows:

- HUF 15,000 for up to 25 firearms and/or ammunition up to 5000 pcs,
- HUF 35,000 for between 26–50 firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition
- HUF 45,000 for 50+ firearms and/or 10,000 pcs. of ammunition.

The administrative service fee payable for exchanging and replacing the licence shall be HUF 4,000 (in the case of ammunition only, it is free of charge).

The administrative service fee is payable to the appropriation allocation bank account held by the relevant county police department in the first instance; in Budapest, the Budapest Police Headquarters. The payment must be effected not later than on the business day following the receipt of the registration number issued by the relevant authority. In the description of the payment, the reason of the payment (e.g. *automata lőfegyver tartása* – licence to possess automatic firearms) together with the registration number of the case (registration number: 'RZSEIR' registration number indicated in the communication sent by the document management system of the Police to the applicant's Customer Gateway storage space) must be indicated.

Attachments to be added to the application submitted in pdf files

- Documents referring to the verification of the special conditions as stipulated in G.d.;
- in the case of employees, a test certificate evidencing the applicant's theoretical knowledge and practical skills required to possess firearms (firearms safety certificate), a certificate of the preliminary medical assessment (issued by the relevant occupational health authority). The examination/assessment has a medical and a psychological component;
- a sketch and security description of the firearms and ammunition storage facility, if available.

In the case of applications for replacement of a licence to possess automatic firearms, only the document evidencing the fact of its loss or theft should be attached.

Processing the application

If during processing the application, it is established that the entitled applicant has submitted the complete application to the authority having appropriate jurisdiction, or the applicant has complied with the request for correction or amendment, and the conditions of the application as required by the law have been met, the authority shall issue a licence to possess firearms (licence). The decision is an electronically authenticated and generated document. The licence and the official card evidencing the licence (document/card) can be collected by the licence holder in person via their authorised trade representative from the licensing police authority during business hours.

In the case of the exchange of the licence to possess automatic firearms, due to wear and damage, or its replacement, due to loss or theft, the new licence can be collected in person. Simultaneously with collecting the new licence, the licence to be exchanged must be handed into the authority.
